4. Special Collection Please note, there are special collections on November 2 (All Souls Day) and Nov. 9 (Priests Retirement Fund).

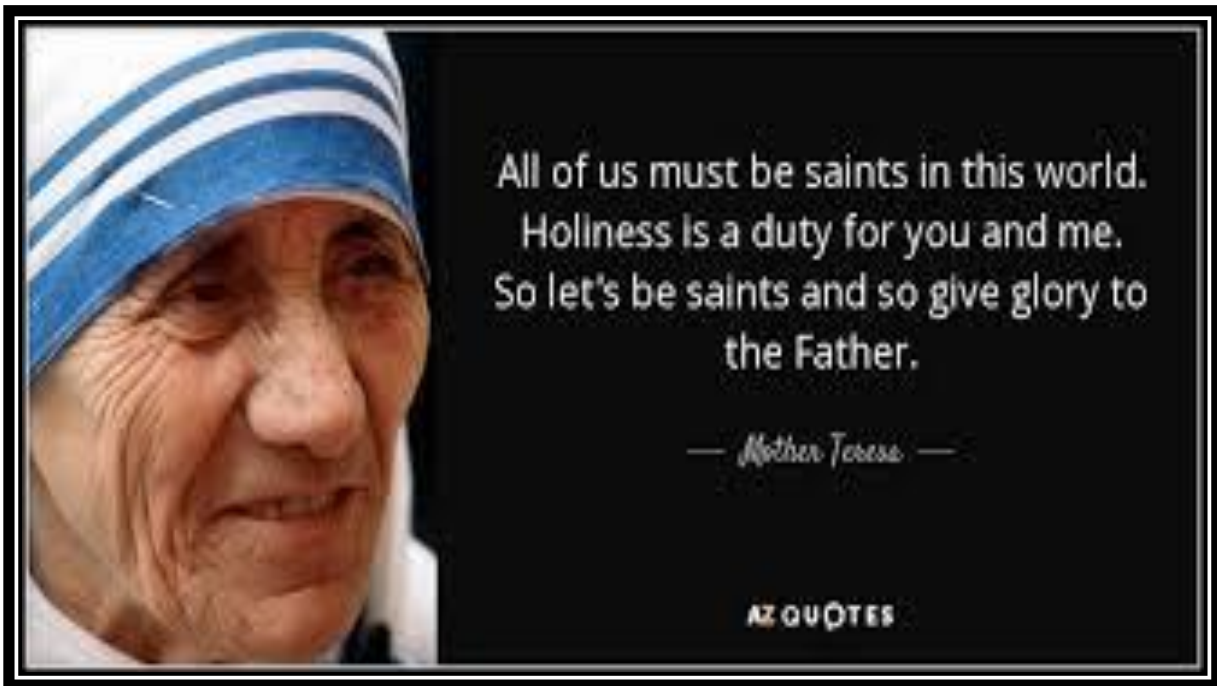
